

# نَعْتٌ وَمَنْعُوتٌ

مَنْعُوتٌ



Qualifying Noun

The نَعْتٌ (adjective) in Arabic follows the مَنْعُوتٌ (noun it qualifies) in the following:

**Gender:** The نَعْتٌ (adjective) follows the مَنْعُوتٌ (qualifying noun) in gender, so if the noun is feminine then the adjective is also feminine e.g.

بَيْتٌ صَغِيرٌ  
طَالِبَةٌ صَغِيرَةٌ

**Definite:** The نَعْتٌ (adjective) follows the مَنْعُوتٌ (qualifying noun) in definiteness, so if the مَنْعُوتٌ is definite then the نَعْتٌ is also definite e.g.

الْمُدْرَسُ الْجَدِيدُ فِي الْفَصْلِ

**Case:** The نَعْتٌ (adjective) takes the same case endings as the مَنْعُوتٌ (qualifying noun) e.g.

هَذَا بَيْتٌ جَدِيدٌ  
أَنَا فِي بَيْتٍ جَدِيدٍ  
الْبَيْتُ الْجَدِيدُ جَمِيلٌ

**Plural:** The نَعْتٌ (adjective) follows the مَنْعُوتٌ (qualifying noun) in number e.g.

طَالِبٌ وَاحِدٌ  
طَالِبَانِ اثْنَانِ  
الرِّجَالُ الْقِصَارُ ذَهَبُوا إِلَى السُّوقِ
