

Pattern I
مُعْتَلِّ الْعَيْنِ
(أجوف)

Weak of 'Ayn (mu'tallul-ayn) verbs have a weak letter as the second root letter. There are three different conjugation patterns for mu'tallul-'ayn verbs. In this chart, we have those verbs conjugated on the pattern of **جَاءَ، يَجِيءُ**. Some mu'tallul-'ayn verbs¹ conjugated on this pattern are:

جاء	To come		عاش	To live
باع	To sell		سار	To go/travel
خاب	To fail		غاب	To be absent
زان	To decorate		قاس	To measure

Example: **جاءَ، يَجِيءُ**

نَجِيءُ	We are coming		أَجِيءُ	I am coming
تَجِيئُونَ	You (m.pl) are coming		تَجِيءُ	You (m.sg) are coming
تَجِيئْنَ	You (f.pl) are coming		تَجِيئِينَ	You (f.sg) are coming
يَجِيئُونَ	They (m) are coming		يَجِيءُ	He is coming
يَجِيئْنَ	They (f) are coming		تَجِيءُ	She is coming

Amr (command) form

جِيئِي	Go! (f.sg)		جِيئِ	Go! (m.sg)
جِيئْنَ	Go! (f.pl)		جِيئُوا	Go! (m.pl)
