

Pattern I
مُعْتَلُّ اللّام
(نَاقِص)

Weak of laam verbs (mu'tallul-laam) have a weak letter as the third root letter. There are three different conjugation patterns for mu'tallul-laam verbs. In this chart, we have those verbs conjugated on the pattern of مَشَى، يَمْشِي

Some mu'tallul-laam verbs¹ conjugated on this pattern are:

عَنَى	To mean		رَمَى	To throw
بَكَى	To cry		بَنَى	To build
جَرَى	To flow		هَدَى	To guide

Example: مَشَى، يَمْشِي

نَمْشِي	We are walking		أَمْشِي	I am walking
تَمْشُونَ	You (m.pl) are walking		تَمْشِي	You (m.sg) are walking
تَمْشِينَ	You (f.pl) are walking		تَمْشِينَ	You (f.sg) are walking
يَمْشُونَ	They (m) are walking		يَمْشِي	He is walking
يَمْشِينَ	They (f) are walking		تَمْشِي	She is walking

Amr (command)

إَمْشِي	Walk! (f.sg)		إَمْشِ	Walk! (m.sg)
إَمْشِينَ	Walk! (f.pl)		إَمْشُوا	Walk! (m.pl)
